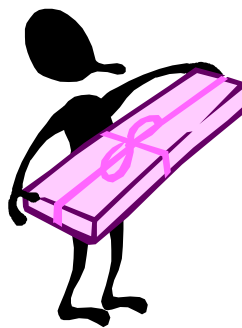
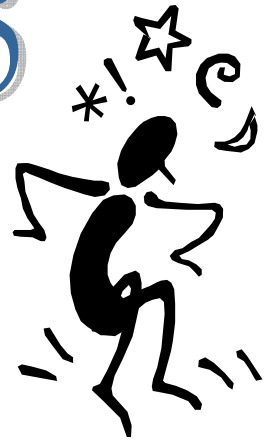

Adjetivos



Use the adjectives with the correct form of SER.

For females, the adjective needs to be feminine.
The "O" should be changed to an "A"

For more than one person, the adjective needs to be plural.

*Add an "S" to the end if it ends in a vowel
or "ES" if it does not*



In Spanish, SER means 'to be'

It is used with adjectives, professions, and other things that stay the same.
SER is *not* used with emotions.

The subject determines the correct form of SER. You should recognize the chart and the subjects below.
